Student Hit account

Belgrade, February 5, 2016 - Banca Intesa has created a special offer for students – Student Hit account that involves fee-free dinar and foreign exchange account opening, reception of money from the country and abroad, as well as free text messages about cash payments. Also, during the first year of the account package use, students will not be charged monthly account maintenance fee and will be able to use Visa Inspire payment card for free. Moreover, having in mind the habits and needs of young people – to conduct as many of their obligations as possible online – Student Hit account also enables the use of mobile and internet banking for free.

“Although regarded as one of the best times in life, studying at the university brings many changes and new responsibilities in the lives of young people, and it is often the first step towards financial independence. In order to support students on that path, we have created an offer that meets their everyday financial needs in a simple way. In addition, we want to encourage them to start using advanced banking services and educate them about the importance of responsible management of finances, whether they have already started to earn money themselves or are still relying on their parents’ support,” said Niksa Ilovic, Head of Banca Intesa Individuals Segment Management Department.

Visa Inspire international debit card allows Student Hit account holders to make free cash withdrawals at Banca Intesa ATMs in Serbia and ATMs belonging to Intesa Sanpaolo group in 11 countries of the region, make fee-free shopping payments in the country and abroad and safe online purchases. Also, the card can be linked to a PayPal account and used to make contactless payments at points of sale that accept payWave transactions.

Furthermore, Banca Intesa’s e-banking services – Intesa Mobi and Intesa On-line – that are available 24 hours a day, 365 days a year, offer Student Hit account holders fee-free payment of first three bills in a month, regardless of the bill amount, as well as the possibility to buy the euro at a preferential rate via EUR NET option, check the balance on their account and card. Another benefit is the option to search the location of Banca Intesa’s branch offices and ATMs.
